- Regularly check for symptoms in staff and children and regularly use a thermometer to check temperatures;
- Inform you if staff or children in your child's 'bubble' show symptoms of COVID-19 as this will mean you will all need to self-isolate for at least 14 days or until the test comes back negative;
- Continue our clear and consistent approach to rewards and sanctions for children as set out in the Behaviour Policy as well the expectations outlined in this agreement;
- Communicate between home and school through notices, newsletters, text, email and the school website.

# Parent/ carer

Parent/Carer.....

## To help my child at school, I know and understand that:

- If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school, we will self-isolate for 14 days as a family, I will get them tested and I will let the school know as soon as possible via telephone;
- If my child, or another child in the group, shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school, I will collect my child from school immediately; they will need to self-isolate for 14 days or until tested negative;
- Should a child or adult show symptoms and test positive for COVID-19 then the whole group (bubble) that the child was in will be sent home and they must self-isolate for 14 days.
- On my commute, and when dropping my child off and picking them up, I will adhere to the 2 metre social distancing rules.
- Only one adult should drop off or pick up;
- When dropping off and picking up, I will strictly stick to the school timings for my child;
- My child must not bring any items into school with them or take items home from school. Do not bring a school bag of any sort;
- My child may have their temperature taken during the day, especially if they feel or present as being unwell
- I will need to remind my child about social distancing rules but accept they are difficult to follow and that my child may not always do this successfully
- My child will need to use good respiratory and hand hygiene;
- I will not be allowed into the school without a pre-arranged appointment – make appointments via telephone or email;
- If my child's behaviour results in staff and children being unsafe I understand that they may need to stay at home and lose their place in school;
- Read all letters/messages/emails that are sent home; and action as requested
- I need to inform the school immediately of any changes to parents/carers and emergency contacts details.
- My child should wear school uniform ( School jumper/ t shirt will suffice . Trainers may be the most suitable footwear for day to day wear) This should be washed each evening.
- My child may not be in a group with their usual friends in order to maintain rules laid out by government
- Ensure your child does not mix with children (*not from their own household*) out of school hours. This would result in your child having to stay at home for two weeks to ensure the safety of other children who are observing social distancing rules.
