I know this is an anxious time for some of you and the return to school feels like a huge milestone for us all. We are very glad to be back and so happy to see the children back to school and enjoying time with their friends.

School feels very calm and safe and staff are working hard to make sure our two bubbles of children are safe. We have passed on some inconvenience to you with our staggered start and finish times in school and I am very aware that this is going to be difficult for some of you. It is particularly difficult for those with siblings in different bubbles. If you do have siblings in different groups, from next week, please send in both siblings at the earliest drop off time. I will greet them both but ensure they go to their separate classrooms safely, without compromising the safety of others in the group. I hope this will ease some of difficulties you have experienced. For everyone else, can I ask that you stick closely to the drop off and pick up times. Please do not arrive early and please or arrive late. If you arrive early we will ask you to wait until the time advertised to ensure that we can keep our groups separate. I know this may be inconvenient, but we are making these arrangements in order to adhere to the guidelines we have been issued with and ultimately in order to keep the whole school community as safe as possible.

Please can I remind you that access to the school building is strictly by appointment only. Please telephone the office to make an appointment. We ask that you do not come to the school office to ask for an appointment, it must be done by phone.

Breakfast and Teatime Club will resume next week. Breakfast Club will open at 8.30am and Teatime Club will close at 4.00pm. Bubbles of children will be separated throughout which means places will be limited to 10 per session. Each session will be £1.50 per child. Sessions must be booked by contacting school and paid for on Parent Pay. No Food or snacks will be provided initially, these will be introduced over the next couple of weeks.
