#### Homework

**Homework—** Homework tasks for Y3 and Y4 are in homework books. Please return homework no later than Wednesday.

Reading books and library books should be brought to school on a daily basis. Please try to read at least 10 minutes each night or as much as you can manage.

Instrument lessons will take place on Wednesday. Please ensure your child has their instrument for this lesson.
