Dear Parent / Guardian

On Friday this week we will not send home a newsletter.

There will be no PE or outdoor learning. There will also be no homework tasks this week.

Please see below more details for some of our Christmas Activities.

### **Monday 14<sup>th</sup> December**

Children will do Christmas crafts and think about the Nativity.

### **Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> December**

Children will continue with their Christmas crafts and Nativity story that will be started on Monday.

During the afternoon they will be able to go to the fair in their bubble.

At the fair we will have the raffle, a chocolate game (50p per go), guess the name games (£1), guess the weight (50p per go) and a stall with hair accessories (£1 each). Please put any money you are sending to school in a named envelope to minimise the risk of it getting lost.

### **Wednesday 16<sup>th</sup> December**

Children can wear Christmas jumpers. They are not required to wear school trousers or school skirt with their jumper. Please remember that they will have all playtimes as normal and the yard can be quite muddy so it is advisable that they do not come in their best clothes. We have asked that children DO NOT wear party clothes. There will be no changing of clothes allowed in line with COVID19 guidelines.

We will also have our Christmas Dinner. This will be served in the usual bubbles. If your child is on packed lunch and has opted for a Christmas Dinner this will show on your parent pay account (if applicable).

Your child will then enjoy their Christmas party during the afternoon. They will bring home a bag containing some snacks.

### **Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> December**

The children are able to purchase Christmas Movie tickets for £1. The tickets cover the cost of snacks and drinks while they watch the movie. This can be sent into school from now until the morning of the 17th. On Christmas Movie day the children can come into school in comfortable clothes (including PJs if they want to). Whatever they wear must be practical for all activities during the day including playtimes. The junior children will watch the movie in the hideaway(tent) which is cooler than the classroom so they will need to be dressed warmly. Junior children are welcome to bring in a small cushion/ blanket (they must be able to fit in their locker) so they can comfortably relax and lounge whilst watching the film. Just a reminder that we ask that you do not send Christmas cards into school this year.
