All children have rights as well as responsibilities. In our school we work together to promote the rights of everyone on our school and global community.

We strive to ensure that all behaviour in school for adults and children will demonstrate the rights and responsibilities we have adopted.

This policy has been produced by staff, parents, pupils, parents/carers and governors of our school and reflects our school mission statement and aims. It should be read alongside the school policies concerning anti bullying strategies, child protection and equal opportunities.

The whole school community has helped to produce this policy so that children can learn and develop in the safest and securest way possible. We believe in having a positive approach and will reward children for their achievements as much as possible. We want all children to enjoy school and learn about their rights and responsibilities which will help make our school a happy, positive and learning place.

If we need extra help with our Rights and Responsibilities; the following activities may be used:

- **Home School log –so we all work together – families, children and school.**
- **An individual behaviour plan with targets to aim for to help us to understand and follow our rights and responsibilities**
- **Work with outside agencies such as the behaviour Support Service or the Educational Psychology Service.**

We have the Right to be listened to
We have the responsibility to listen to other people

We have the rights to come to school and learn
We have the responsibility to try our best every day

We have the right to be helped, looked after and be happy
We have the responsibility to look after everyone, help them if they need it and cheer them up if they are sad.

We have the right to be safe when we are anywhere in our school

We have the responsibility to help everyone to be safe on our school.

We have adopted Rights & Responsibilities to help us to be happy in school. They are on display in the school Hall and we often share them in assembly time when we need to remind ourselves of them and to help us to understand them and to follow them.

We have decided that the following actions will be applied if we forget to carry out our responsibilities.

- **Warning (Maximum of 2)**
- **Sit away from your group**
- **Lose some playtime or lunchtime**
- **Discuss your behaviour with your class teacher**
- **Go to see Mrs Jones to discuss your behaviour**
- **Sad note / letter to take home (from Class teacher or Headteacher)**

- **Parents invited in to school to discuss your behaviour**
